

Sports Partnership Promotion Programme Application Criteria

APPLICATION CRITERIA

A. WHAT KIND OF EVENTS/PROGRAMMES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE?

SPPP will not cover applications of the following nature:

1. Funding for events/programmes that do not have any sports element at all.
2. Funding for events/programmes that have commenced prior to the application.
3. Funding for participations in local and overseas competitions except for adventure/extreme sports applicants.
4. Funding for adventure/extreme sports that does not directly promote team-building, character development or public interest in sports.
5. Funding for formation and operation of any specific/private sports club/team.
6. Funding for capital expenditure such as costs of buildings, purchase of equipment etc.
7. Funding for full/part time staffing.
8. Funding for non mass participation events/programmes.

B. FINANCIAL CRITERIA:

Please note that approval of an application in one year or several consecutive years does not commit SSC to future funding.

Applications will only be considered eligible for funding under the SPPP if:

1. The organization has no monies outstanding (in arrears) to SSC. In the event that a recommendation is made to provide funding for a program or event from which SSC is owed outstanding monies, SSC reserves the right to reduce the recommended amount by the amount of monies outstanding
2. The funding request is clearly for deficit funding or to make up funding shortfalls resulting from sports-related programs or events

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C. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Applications will only be considered eligible for funding under the SPPP if:

1. Organisations include all sports and recreation clubs, societies, associations, institutions, non-profit organizations, government agencies, grassroots organizations, corporations and self-help groups incorporated or registered in Singapore.
2. The application is submitted using the most current funding application form. This ensures that all submitted applications can be equally assessed using the same evaluation criteria, same evaluation process and based upon similar submitted information.
3. The application is duly signed by the appropriate signing authority for the organization submitting the application. Applications signed by unauthorized employees will not be considered.
4. The organization demonstrates that it is making efforts to provide equal access to services for individuals of diverse cultures, races and disabilities, where appropriate and feasible.
5. The applicant demonstrates clear boundaries, within both its program and budget, between religious activities and the program requesting a cash grant for those applicants operating under the guidance of any religious group.
6. The funds requested are clearly to be used for a program or event offered by the organization. Applications will not be considered for organizations that act in the capacity of a funding agency that makes financial allocations or contributions to other groups

D. ADDITIONAL CRITERIA:

Recurrent events:

Recurrent events/programmes are defined as events/programmes that have been support previously by SPPP. Funding for recurrent events will be on a sliding scale until the 4th year, where funding will cease for the event. This is to ensure that partners are able to grow independently and be less reliant on SSC for support. SSC may consider increasing funds for recurrent initiatives with the proviso that these initiatives have grown in scale and magnitude over the previous years.
